Day 1: UK- KATHMANDU : Depart from UK to Kathmandu.

Day 2: KATHMANDU Arrive Kathmandu, The group would be transferred to the hotel. Overnight in Hotel. **L,D**

Day 3: KATHMANDU- POKHARA- VIA MONOKAMNA ; After breakfast,drive to Pokhara stopping en route at Kurintar for Cable Ride (subject to availability) to MANAKAMNA TEMPLE –" Wish Fulfilling Goddess " . Proceed to Pokhara.Over night at Hotel **B,L,D**

Day 4: POKHARA- JOMSOM : After Breakfast Fly Pokhara / Jomsom by Fixed Wing Craft. Transfer to Muktinath Temple by Jeep / Pony. Afternoon Muktinath Darshan. O/nt in Jomsom **B,L,D**

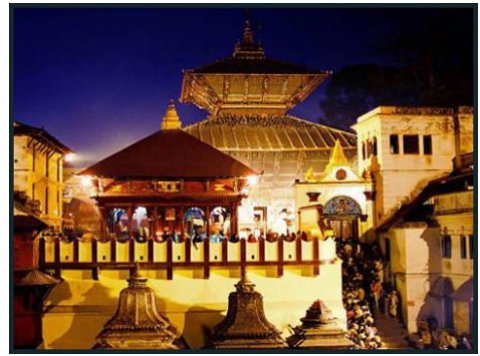
Day 5: JOMSOM- POKHARA : After breakfast fly Jomsom/ - **B,L,D**

Day 06: POKHARA- JANAKPUR: After Breakfast, Proceed to Janakpur. O/nt at Hotel . **B,L,D**

Day 7: JANAKPUR- KATHMANDU : In the morning, Darshan Of Janaki Mandir. PM Fly Janakpur / Kathmandu . Transfer to Hotel . O/nt at Hotel **B,L,D**



Day 8 : PASHUPATINATH DARSHAN : Sight Seeing in Kathmandu including Pashupatinath and Bhudhanilkantha Darshan. Evening: Clothing inspection and tour briefing, Dinner and overnight at hotel



Day 9 : KATHMANDU- Kodari : Early morning depart from Kathmandu to Kodari. Visit 138feet Lord Shiva Statue. Overnight at Kodari.

Day 10: Kodair - NYALAM : Depart to Nyalam. Cross Friendship bridge. Immigration. Overnight stay at Guest House / Camp.

Day 11: Acclimatization : After breakfast, Hiking or Soft Trekking for 3 hours to Acclimatize. Later evening Satsang or Bhajan at Guest House. Meal at Guest House. Overnight Stay.

Day 12: Nyalam - SAGA : Depart to Saga. Arrival in Afternoon. Lunch at Saga. Overnight stay at Guest House / Camp.

Day 13: SAGA- PARYANG : Drive to Prayang - after breakfast we drive across the vast Tibetan plateau to Prayang (225 km). Packed lunch will be served, O/nt camp/guest house.



Day 14: PARYANG- HERR CHU : From Prayang to Lake Manasarovar Camp at Herr Chu. The auspicious day for all travelers having first glimpse of the Holy Manas and Darshan (view) of Mt.Kailash from The Herr Chu pass . Camp for night on the shores of Lake Manasarovar .

Day 15: MANSAROVAR : Rest in Lake Mansarovar . The experience of being in the abode of God, while we spend 1 day in Lake Mansarovar it will help us to acclimatize, we can take bath then Drive to Darchen, if time permit trek up to Gangtak Gompa to view close view of Holy Kailash.



Day 16: PARIKRAMA- DIRAPUK : Start Parikrama of Kailash - early in the morning, trek up to Diraphuk (north face of Kailash)

Day 17: ZUTULPHUK : Trek to Zuthulphuk Gompa - Parikrama - the day of challenging journey that every pilgrim talks about. We trek up to Dolma La Pass (5600 m), offer very short Prayers at the Dolmala and go down towards the Gaurikunda. Lunch and dinner, as usual, will be provided at the camp, in front of medicine Buddha Mountain near by Zuthulphuk Gompa.

Day 18: PARIKRAMA FINSHES – DRIVE MANSAROVAR : Zuthulphuk - Darchen - after breakfast, we trek to reach the point where our jeeps will be waiting for us and drive to Darchen, or we can walk. Parikrama ends and same day drive to Herr Chu. Lake Mansarovar to fill the holy water in bottle.



Day 19: SAGA : We return through the same route. The same procedure as earlier will be followed for meals and accommodation. Drive to Saga

Day 20: Drive back to Nyalam

Day 21: Drive to Kathmandu

Day 22: Kathmandu: Day free at Leisure or for shopping.

Day 23: Kathmandu – departure to airport for your flight to onward destination.

1) Our normal cancellation charges apply as a percentage of the total yatra cost. We will require notice in writing for any cancellation made by you. Below cancellation charges apply:

2) If we cancel the yatra for any reason: Full Refund of paid money.

4) Fully filled Booking form should be submitted at least 60 days before the provisional date of departure.

5) With booking form we require following details:

Full name as in passport, Date of birth, Nationality, Sex, Occupation and Health Questionnaire Form.

6) As yatra contains visiting High altitude areas, Customer must consult their GP and get advice before travel to high altitude area. This is passenger's own responsibility to disclose correct medical condition information to us.

7) The Itinerary can change without notice due to unavoidable circumstances beyond our control such as political unrest; natural calamities, ACT OF GOD or changes in the Itinerary due to Chinese authorities etc & further charges might be applicable & will be borne by the client. Any unused services are non refundable under any circumstances and not negotiable.

8) Upon the confirmation 100% deposit is required before 60 days of the commencement of the tour along with passport. Deposit is non-refundable.
